

Pollinator Posse Seed Ball Recipe

Used for Tees for Bees

5 parts powdered clay from pottery store or heavy clay soil

1 part compost

1 Tbl Seeds - wildflower and milkweed

About 1 part water maybe less

As a measuring cup I use a 9 oz plastic drink cup but you can scale up or down accordingly



- Add water slowly and stir after each addition
- Err on the side of too little water - beware if it gets too wet it's a slippery mess and balls won't hold together
- Dry in direct sun or even better in a hot greenhouse for a few days
- This makes a very sticky mixture. Cleanup can be a challenge – both of hands and containers best done outside. Be careful not to pour any of this down the drain unless you want to hire a plumber.

Make sure you have owner or land manager's permission to toss or hit seed balls onto their property.
